Make sure you know them before your SATs and Secondary School.

<i>Word</i>	<i>Meaning</i>	<i>Example Sentence</i>
accidentally	To happen by accident.	Ms Soar accidentally knocked over the jug of water.
actually	To really happen.	Year 5 will actually take their SATs in four months.
address	The place where a building is.	Downsell Primary School's address is 34 Downsell Road.
answer	To reply.	Mrs Smith will answer the phone when it rings.
appear	To come into view.	If you rub a magic lamp, a genie might appear.
arrive	To reach your destination.	When you arrive at school, hang up your coat on the hook.
believe	To accept as true.	Some children don't believe in the tooth fairy.
bicycle	A vehicle with two wheels and two pedals.	The mayor of London wants more people to ride a bicycle.
breath	To take in air to the lungs.	Miss Payne took a breath of fresh air.
breathe	To take in air to the lungs and out again in a regular rhythm.	After running for one mile, I could not breathe properly.
