<i>Word</i>	<i>Meaning</i>	<i>Example Sentence</i>
enough	When there is enough of something and you do not need any more.	I have eaten enough pizza; I am full up.
exercise	When you exercise, you move to keep your body fit.	Children should exercise for at least sixty minutes a day.
experience	Having knowledge or skill because you have learnt or done something.	Failing the test was not a happy experience.
experiment	To test an idea.	We carried out an experiment with seeds in Science.
extreme	Something extreme is far out, either in distance or intensity.	Examples of extreme sports are hang-gliding and surfing.
famous	Something or someone famous is well-known.	Donald Trump is one of the most famous people in the world.
favourite	Something you like very much.	Many people's favourite drink is milk.
February	February is the second month of the year.	February has 28 days but each leap year it has 29.
forward(s)	Forward is the direction or time in front of you.	I am looking forward to playing football on Thursday.
fruit	Fruit is what a plant produces after it has been pollinated.	All fruits have seeds, including apples, grapes and bananas.
