foreign	from a different country or language to your own	The new girl spoke in a foreign language I hadn't heard before.
forty	the number 40	Double twenty is forty.
frequently	often	Ms Soar frequently goes swimming at Cathall pool.
government	the group of people with power to rule the country	The government introduced a new law to stop crime.
guarantee	a formal, written agreement	My dad's new car has a guarantee it will work for five years.
harass	to not leave someone in peace	Mum began to harass the me for not doing my homework.
hindrance	something that blocks something or someone	High heels can be a hindrance to running fast.
