<i>Word</i>	<i>Meaning</i>	<i>Example Sentence</i>
absorbed	soak up or give complete attention to	Enoch was absorbed as he watched the sponge absorbing the liquid.
delivered	help something arrive	The baby was delivered in the hospital.
designed	something done with a specific purpose	Social distancing is designed to reduce the spread of Covid-19.
disappeared	something has vanished or gone away	Many items in the shops have disappeared.
disturbed	something has moved, changed or troubled	People are disturbed by the Coronavirus.
developed	something becoming more advanced, developed or useful	Scientists developed a vaccine for the virus.
echoed	a repetition or imitation of sound	The laughter echoed around the room.
fouled	something dirty or tangled	Kris was fouled in the penalty area.
rehearsed	practiced and ready	The children rehearsed for their performance in DGT.
transformed	changed from what they were like before	The streets were transformed and quiet once lockdown started.
transported	moved over a distance from place to place	Food was transported in lorries from farms to the city.
