Dear Parent/Carer,

You may have noticed that schools have started to reopen and I would like to thank all children and parents who have worked extremely hard to ensure home learning has taken place. Next year, your child will be in year 5 and we realise the concerns you may have with regards to missed time at school. We would like to help support your child with regards to learning missed at school and it is for this reason we would like Year 4 children to return to school from Monday 29th June. Due to the social distancing restrictions every child will only stay at school for half a day. You can choose which session you would like your child to attend:

Morning session - 9 am – 11:45 am
Afternoon session – 12:45 pm – 3:30 pm

Children will be taught by the current Year 4 teachers and the learning will be focused on reading, writing and maths.

Although children are staying only for half a day, you can still order school dinner for them. If they attend morning sessions they will be given their school dinner to take home after they finish the school. If you choose the afternoon session, you can collect the school dinners from 11 o'clock and let your child have it at home before they come to school for the afternoon.

In light of COVID-19, I would like to reassure you that we have taken all necessary steps to ensure the safety and well-being of all children and staff when at school. We have successfully started school for children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 and we are very pleased with all our safety measures in place.

- All classes have bubbles of no more than 13 children
- All children are given equipment clearly labelled with their names and for their use only
- The children will have designated adults who will not mix in other bubbles
- We have robust systems in place to ensure regular washing of hands and soap and tissues are provided
- Social distancing is expected at all times

We all recognise the impact school closure will have on children's learning and this is an opportunity to start supporting our children. If you would like to discuss this further please do not hesitate to get in touch with me.

Please note you must give us 48 hours' notice if you would like for your child to attend the school. No child will be allowed in any bubble without 48 hours' notice.

I look forward to welcoming your child back to school from next week.
