

Claim up to £3,000 worth of free childcare for your twoyear-old

If your child was born between 1 September 2017 and December 2017 you could be eligible for a two-year-old space from January 2020 and receive up to 15 hours free childcare each week.

Attending these sessions supports your child's learning alongside the learning they do at home with you.

Have you checked to see if you qualify for Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE).

Claim up to £6,000 worth of free childcare for your three or four-year-old child

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 and lives in Waltham Forest, they can take up a place in a school reception class from September 2020.

If you would like you child to take up a school reception class place in September 2020, you will need to submit an application to Waltham Forest School Admissions Service.



Applying for a Reception place for September 2020

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 they are due to start in Reception class at a primary school from September 2020.

You must apply for a Reception place for your child even if they attend a school nursery or have an older brother or sister at your preferred school. If your child currently attends a nursery attached to a school this does not give them any priority for a place in Reception at that school.

The booklet <u>Starting Primary School 2020</u> contains all the information you need to know about applying for a Reception class place. Please check the Latest Admissions Information below for updates to this booklet.

The <u>eAdmissions website</u> for online applications opens on 1 September and the closing date for on time applications is 15 January 2020. If you apply after 15 January your application will be considered as late and will be processed after all the on time applications.

If you and your child live in Waltham Forest you must apply through us. If you and your child live outside Waltham Forest, you must apply to the local authority in which you live. The <u>eAdmissions web-</u> <u>site</u> will redirect your application to the correct local authority based on the address and postcode you enter.

If you are unable to apply online you can download the <u>primary common application form</u>. Instructions for how to submit your paper application are on the tack of the application form.

To register for FUN KIDS after school care, please pop into the school office, and collect and application pack.

FUN KIDS runs from 3.20pm— 7.00pm and costs £10 per session. This will include games and activities, as well as a healthy snack and a drink.
