WALTHAM FOREST IMMUNISATION TEAM WILL BE VISITING YOUR SCHOOL SOON

The children's flu vaccine is offered as a yearly nasal spray to young children from the age of 4 up to year 7 to protect them against the flu.

Flu can be a very unpleasant illness for children, with potentially serious complications, including bronchitis & pneumonia.

The vaccine is given as a single spray squirted up each nostril. Not only is it needle free, the nasal spray is quick and painless and works better than the injected flu vaccine.

You will receive a consent form from your school, these must be returned either if consenting or refusing the vaccine.

If we miss your child for any reason you will be invited to attend one of our clinic's that we hold in
