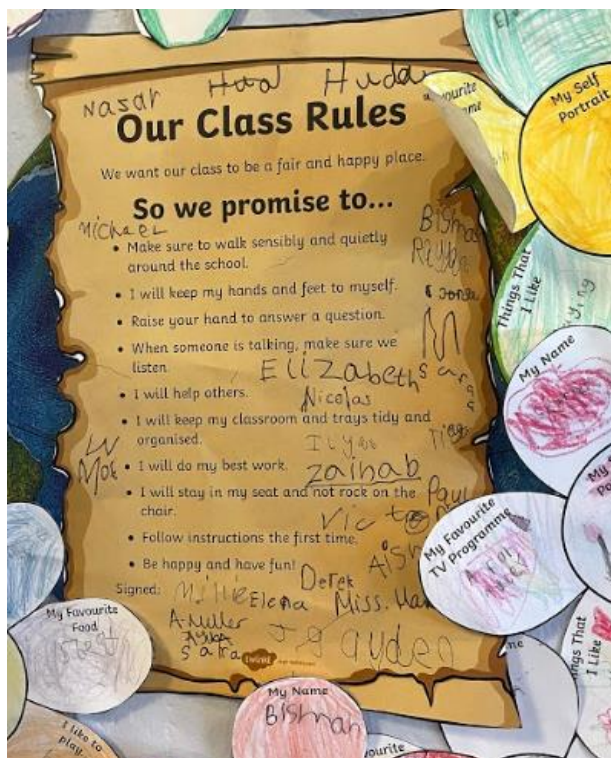

LI: What does a Mezuzah remind Jewish people about?

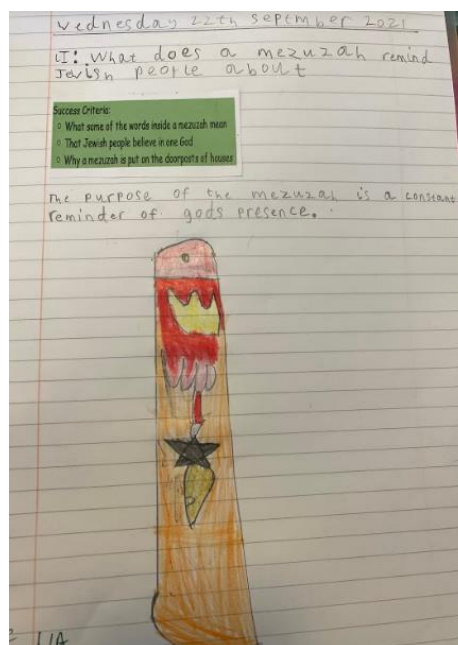

Year 2's Geography lessons looked at the following learning intentions:

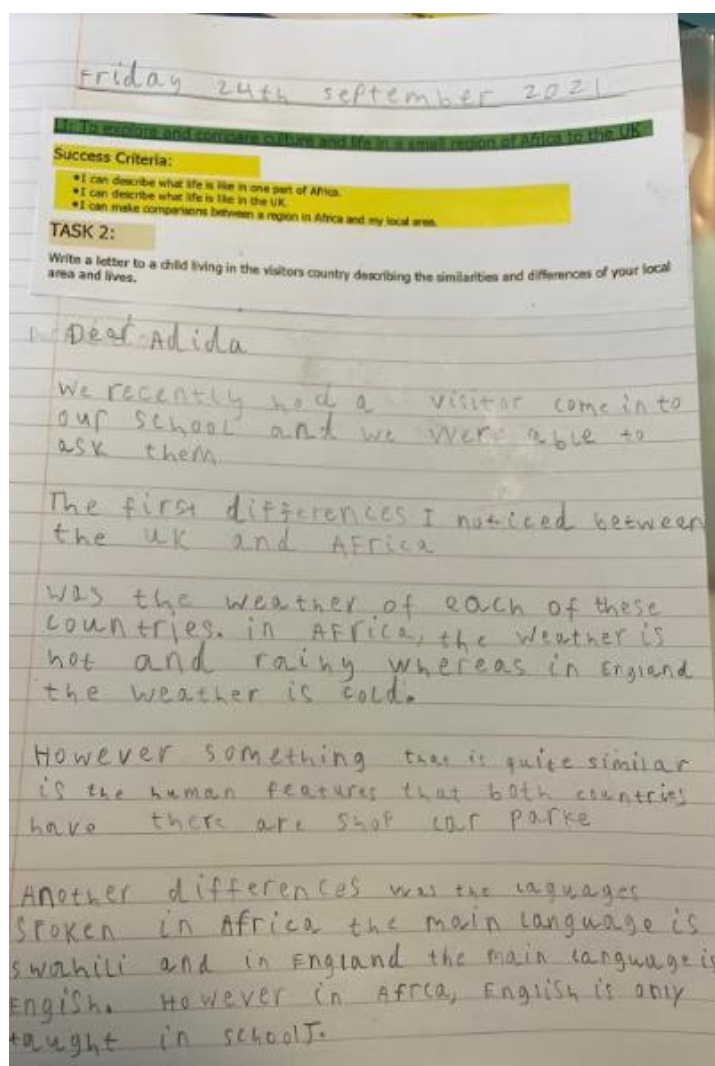
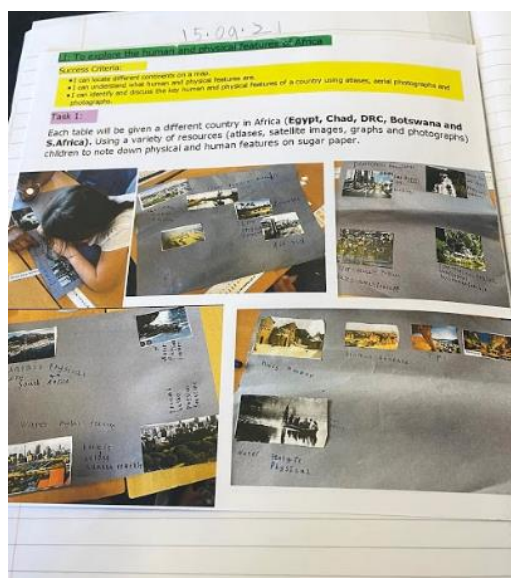
LI: To explore the human and physical features of Africa
